The Joint meeting of SWRM/SERM regions of the ACS meets every 10 years in New Orleans.

The ACS is the world's largest scientific association and our two joint regions encompass a large portion of all ACS members, from Texas to Florida (including Puerto Rico) up to Virginia and across to Oklahoma.
